9 years ago, this country witnessed the worst terrorist attack in our history. What we also witnessed was brave men & women rushing into harm's way to ensure the safety of NYC & our beloved country. These brave souls, uniformed & non-uniformed, were promised help by the federal government, and after 9 years they are still waiting. In July, our bill, H.R. 847, was voted down by a procedure that splintered an already partisan House of Representatives. On September 15th at the U.S. Capitol, we will demand a floor date in September & a regular up & down rules vote on H.R. 847.
